**Read this information carefully.
You may be able to resolve your
complaint without having to appear in
court.**

1. If you are a **JUVENILE** (under 18 years of age), **regardless of your charge, you must appear in person on your initial appearance date WITH A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.**
2. If you are an **adult** (18 years of age or older) and charged with any criminal traffic or criminal offense, you **MUST** appear in person on your initial appearance date and go before a judge.
3. If you are an **adult** (18 years of age or older) and charged with a civil traffic offense, you may:
Admit Responsibility: Pay fine by mail, in person or online, on or before the date listed on your citation. (to pay online go to www.orovalleyaz.gov, and click on Online Services. An online fee will be assessed),
Deny Responsibility: You may request a hearing. Instructions are on the reverse side of this form.
Attend Defensive Driving School: This will only dismiss one moving violation. Instructions are on the reverse side of this form.

FAILURE TO RESPOND on a civil traffic complaint by the **appearance date** will result in a **default judgment** against you for the bond/fine amount, plus a late and default fee of \$70. **Your driver license will be suspended** until the fine/sanction and fees are paid in full.

FAILURE TO APPEAR by the appearance date on the citation for a **Criminal** or **Criminal Traffic** charge will result in a warrant being issued for your arrest and your driver license being suspended.

NOTICE: Per ARS 12-116, a \$20 onetime fee will be added to each citation not paid in full on the date Court imposes sanctions.

Any unpaid balance may be turned over to a collection agency and/or tax intercept program and collection fees will be assessed.

REPAIRS

If you were cited for any of the following charges:
ARS 28-924A, 28-925A, 28-931C, 28-939, 28-941,
28-952, 28-956, 28-957B or 28-957.01A

Equipment Repair Violations may be resolved one of three ways:

- By taking the auto to any police officer or Sheriff's Deputy and have them verify the repair by signing the back of your citation/ticket.
- By taking or faxing a copy of the invoice for the repair to the Oro Valley Magistrate Court.
- Payment of fines/sanction for the vehicle equipment violation. Refer to the bond/fine schedule for your fine amount.

Repair must be completed prior to your appearance date. Proof of repair must be submitted to the court.

MANDATORY INSURANCE

Violation of ARS §28-4135A,B,C

If you had insurance on the date cited on the vehicle you were driving or any vehicle where you are the named insured, mail proof of insurance to reach the court **on or before** your court date and the charge will be **dismissed**.

OR

Fine may be reduced to **\$120** with proof of a six-month insurance policy and a Motor Vehicle Record showing no 28-4135 violations within the past 24 months or no more than one 28-4135 violation in the past 36 months.

REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS

28-2158C\$143
 (No Registration in possession) – Fine may be suspended if you show proof vehicle was registered on violation date, but didn't have it in possession.

28-2153A\$153
 (No current registration/expired registration) - May be suspended if defendant shows proof they do not own the vehicle or may be reduced to \$65 if vehicle is registered after violation date.

28-2532A\$572
 (No current plates/registration) - May be reduced to \$120 if vehicle was registered after violation date.

28-4139A\$480
 (Display plate suspended for financial responsibility) - May be reduced to \$123 with proof of insurance on the vehicle you were driving and obtaining a valid registration **after** you were cited.

If you wish to admit responsibility (civil traffic charges only) and pay your fine, **without appearing in court**, payment must be received **prior** to your court date (located on bottom of citation). Points will be assessed on your driver license by MVD for moving violations.

Refer to the bond/fine schedule located on the reverse side of this sheet for your fine amount. Add \$25 to your total fine for a Court Security Fee per Town Ordinance (O) 10-3, section 5-5-1(A)

We must receive your request for a hearing:

- Complete the section below and mail to the Oro Valley Magistrate Court in the envelope provided. We must receive your request for a hearing on or prior to your appearance date (located on bottom of your citation).

You will be notified by mail of your hearing date.

- We must have your correct mailing address on file. Please confirm below.
- The officer who issued the ticket will be subpoenaed to appear at the hearing.

At your hearing date:

- You must be present (if you do not appear, a default judgment will apply).
- You must be prepared to present evidence and/or examine witnesses before a Judge.

NOTE: When requesting a Hearing, you give up the option of attending Defensive Driving School and having your charge dismissed.

You may post a bond and enclose the amount from the bond/fine schedule listed on the reverse side of this insert. If you did not post a bond and fail to appear on your hearing, Default Judgment will apply and your driver license will be suspended.

ATTEND DEFENSIVE DRIVING SCHOOL(DDS)

Arizona law allows you to resolve **one** moving civil traffic charge by attending *Defensive Driving School (DDS)*.

Juveniles (under 18 yrs old) must have permission from the court to attend DDS.

**YOU MUST COMPLETE A DDS CLASS
SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFORE YOUR
APPEARANCE DATE**

Advantages of attending DDS:

- ❖ One Civil Traffic charge will be dismissed.
- ❖ No points will be assessed against your driver license.
- ❖ You will not have to appear in court on that charge.
- ❖ You will not have to pay a fine for that charge.

You may be eligible to attend DDS if you meet the following criteria:

- ❖ Your citation is for a civil moving violation.
- ❖ You **HAVE NOT** attended a DDS class for an Arizona citation in the past 24 months.
- ❖ Your citation was **NOT** issued as the result of a collision in which any person was seriously injured or killed.
- ❖ Your case is **NOT** set for a hearing.
- ❖ You do **NOT** have a CDL (Commercial Driver License)

NOTE: Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) will require you to attend Traffic Survival School (TSS) if you are found **responsible** for *Red Light Violation(s)* 28-645A3A or 28-647. If you are eligible for Defensive Driving School and complete the class, the violation will be dismissed and MVD will **not** require you to attend TSS.
