TOWN TO FACILITATE CREMATORIUM MEETING

February 12, 2007

The Town of Oro Valley will facilitate a meeting between the owner of the approved crematorium facility in Oro Valley and the neighbors who live near the property where the funeral home and crematorium will be built.

The meeting is scheduled to take place at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 15, at the Mountain View Assembly of God church at 3270 E. Armstrong Lane, about 4 miles North of Rancho Vistoso Boulevard on Oracle Road.

The purpose of the meeting, according to Bob Kovitz, Governmental and Community Relations Administrator for the Town, is to share information about the facility. A representative of the Pima County Department of Environmental Quality has also been invited to the meeting.

Since the Town Council has already approved the design of the facility, it is not anticipated that any Council members will be in attendance at the meeting. The Council heard from many of the neighbors at its February 7 regular meeting and also received petitions from the neighbors.
