TOWN SEEKS DEVELOPMENT BOARD VOLUNTEERS

The Town of Oro Valley is currently accepting applications from local residents to serve on an important citizen board that will help to shape the future of the community.

The Development Review Board (DRB) studies and approves architectural design and layout of proposed development plans. This includes site planning and the relationship of proposed developments to the surrounding environment and the community. Two positions are available, with one term ending on June 30, 2008 and another term ending on June 30, 2009.
