**TOWN SEEKS VOLUNTEER FOR
WATER UTILITY COMMISSION**

The Town of Oro Valley is accepting applications from interested parties to serve on the Town's Water Utility Commission. At the present time, there is one vacancy available for an individual who has knowledge of water related issues, specifically water conservation. Applicants will need to be residents of the Town of Oro Valley. The term of this appointment is through June 30, 2010.

The Oro Valley Water Utility Commission is composed of seven members who advise the Town Council on all issues relating to water, including water rate structure, capital improvements, reclaimed water, and public education.

The Water Utility Commission meets on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. The applicant selected for this particular vacancy on the Oro Valley Water Utility Commission is required to be a resident of the Town .
