OV Seeks Volunteers for County Bicycle Committee

ORO VALLEY, ARIZ (Oct. 31, 2008) — The Town of Oro Valley is accepting applications from local residents to serve as the Town's representative on Pima County's Tucson-Pima County Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC). Volunteers serve a two-year term beginning Jan. 1, 2009. Applicants must be residents of Oro Valley.

This position works in conjunction with Town of Oro Valley staff to provide input on local and regional bicycling issues. Regular BAC meetings occur on the second Wednesday of each month, and are usually held at the Himmel Park Library, 1035 N. Treat Ave. The Town representative is expected to serve on one or more BAC subcommittees, depending on their interests. The Town representative, with other BAC members, will also be responsible for providing support for local and regional events in which bicycling and the work of the BAC may be promoted, such as the 4th Avenue Street Fair, the Bicycle Swap Meet and Clean Air Fest, among others.
