

AMENDMENT #3 TO THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020 Mayor Joseph C. Winfield issued a Mayoral Proclamation of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, such emergency was scheduled to end on March 31st, 2020 at midnight; and

WHEREAS, new information in the region has necessitated the enacting of continued restrictions for the Town of Oro Valley; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Joseph C. Winfield has found it necessary to amend the Town of Oro Valley Mayoral Proclamation of Emergency, make additional pronouncements, and extend the previous deadline of the declaration of emergency; and

WHEREAS, local businesses -- along with related owners, employees, contractors, landlords, and tenants -- are suffering tremendous negative impacts because of COVID-19 emergency recommendations made and/or restrictions imposed by the federal government, the State of Arizona, Pima County, and the Town of Oro Valley; and

WHEREAS, all other provisions of the Town of Oro Valley Mayoral Proclamation of Emergency and Amendments thereto that are not in conflict with this Amendment #3 will remain in force until the emergency previously declared abates and is withdrawn; and


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-307, A.R.S. § 26-311, and Oro Valley Town Code 2-1-3, the elements of which are met under the circumstances.

IT IS PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. All deadlines stated in the Town of Oro Valley Mayoral Proclamation of Emergency and Amendments thereto are hereby extended until such time as the Governor of Arizona lifts the current state of emergency, or unless otherwise modified by proclamation; all restrictions as previously proclaimed by Mayor Joseph C. Winfield or enacted by the Town Manager in response to the current COVID-19 emergency shall remain in full force and effect.
2. Regulation of temporary signs as defined in Oro Valley Zoning Code 28.6, and requirements related to temporary public and quasi-public signs pursuant to Oro Valley Zoning Code 28.9 are hereby suspended in areas zoned for commercial use.
3. Playgrounds, basketball courts, volleyball courts, fenced dog parks and ramadas of Town parks are hereby closed to use by the public effective 8:00 p.m. on March 27, 2020, and Homeowners Associations in control of private recreation areas are urged to take similar steps to preclude usage of these types of amenities to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the community.
4. Personal hygiene businesses, such as hair salons, barber shops, nail salons, massage establishments, and day spas are strongly urged to temporarily close until such time as other emergency business restrictions are lifted.

5. In accordance with A.R.S. §26-307(B), this proclamation shall be effective when a copy is filed in the office of the Town Clerk. All existing laws and rules in conflict of the same are hereby suspended during the time and to the extent that they conflict.
