Cycling and mountain biking

Do you want year-round cycling with scenic views on the smoothest roads in the region? Oro Valley has you covered. A variety of picturesque road bike options await you, from fast straightaways to challenging hills, flanked by two mountain ranges. In some areas of this bike-friendly town, some say the cyclists outnumber the cars! Mountain bikers can head over to the Big Wash Trailhead, just a mile from Honey Bee Canyon Park, for easy access to a mountain biking paradise—considered to be the best in the region—where cactus-dotted landscape with glorious sunrises and sunsets.

Birding

Birding in Oro Valley can be a rewarding experience for bird enthusiasts. Oro Valley is surrounded by diverse ecosystems that attract a wide variety of bird species. Catalina State Park is a birding hot-spot, featuring trails that traverse desert landscapes, riparian areas, and oak woodlands. Honey Bee Canyon Park is also a great birding location, known for its picturesque landscapes and diverse avian population. The area features walking trails through desert vegetation and along the banks of the Honeybee Wash. Keep an eye out for petroglyphs!

Golf and disc golf

Oro Valley and the surrounding area is a golfer's paradise, with several well-known courses offering a TRUE desert experience, including El Conquistador Golf, The Views Golf Club, Golf Club at Dove Mountain, La Paloma and the Omni Tucson National. And in the summer months (June – Sept.) disc golfers can enjoy a championship 18-hole course at the stunning Pusch Ridge Course, nestled at the foot of the Santa Catalina Mountains. Never played disc golf before? Now's your chance!

Tennis and pickleball

Oro Valley has a thriving tennis and pickleball community, with top-notch outdoor facilities featuring fresh air and dramatic mountain views. El Conquistador Tennis offers 31 lighted tennis courts at two locations. Pickleball enthusiasts will enjoy the newly-constructed pickleball courts at the Oro Valley Community & Recreation Center.
