WHEREAS, a global spiritual leader, the Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, stressed that a moral and ethical education empowers every individual to develop their full potential in making the world a better place; and



The name "Lubavitch" comes from the city which served as the movement's headquarters for over a century and means city of love.
