#### Early Master Plan

- System of walking/biking trails
- Areas for wildlife viewing
- Connect Vistoso trails to Community Trail System
- Provide dispersed parking areas
- Provide directional signage
- Repurpose former pond for habitat, education wildlife viewing
- Provide area for family gatherings at former pond
- Repurpose driving range to include educational gardens
- Provide educational opportunities (K to 6)
- Provide interpretive opportunities such as dark sky viewing
- Address wash areas erosion for safety
- Create natural water features for habitat
- Reestablish native vegetation throughout Preserve
- Provide shade and seating areas
- Develop operations and management protocols




