The Town of Oro Valley will once again provide free sandbags to Oro Valley residents who may need to protect areas of their homes from storm runoff. Sandbags can be picked up at Naranja Park (810 W. Naranja Drive) and will be available through September 30, or while supplies last. The sandbags are self-service—please bring your own shovel and be prepared to load your own sand.
