NARANJA PARK EXPANSION PROJECT

CLOSURES/ACCESS CHANGES FOR MARCH & APRIL

March 4: Closure of south entrance at Naranja Drive begins

The south entrance will be closed for 4-6 weeks for Musette Drive bridge and storm drain work. Access to the Archery Range will still be available.

March 6: New north entrance at Tangerine Road opens

The north entrance will be the sole access point to Naranja Park during this construction period. The southern entrance will re-open in mid-April.

These temporary closures are crucial to completing the Naranja Park Expansion successfully, adhering to schedule and budget, as the Town strives to deliver an enhanced park experience for the community.

A grand opening event to unveil all the new park amenities is currently being planned, aligning with favorable weather conditions and project completion.

As we navigate these developments, we appreciate your understanding and cooperation. Stay tuned for updates as we move toward the grand opening of the expanded Naranja Park.
