## Naranja Park Expansion Project is officially underway!



It's an exciting time in Oro Valley Parks and Recreation, as we prepare to break ground on the Naranja Park Expansion Project, a multi-million-dollar investment that will bring exciting new amenities to this already beloved park. Although there may be a few minor adjustments to the final design, the park plans include new multi-sport fields, pickleball courts, splash pad, skate park, pump track, basketball courts, pedestrian walkways and trails, and more! Plans also include making the Musette Drive to Tangerine Road a permanent access point, including safety and access improvements.
