

NARANJA PARK EXPANSION PROJECT



The field turf is growing in and is now being mowed regularly. Crews are working to complete the concrete sidewalk, curbing and fencing around the new fields. The septic system for the new restroom at the skate/bike park is complete, and the second tank between the new fields is being installed. That new system will serve a nine-stall restroom facility at that location. Installation of the potable water line is complete, and prep work has begun on the pickleball courts. Work continues on the parking lots and park roadway. Crews have also been repairing/replacing some of the "wattles" that were damaged during the heavy monsoons. Wattles are an erosion protection measure to reduce surface erosion on slopes and hillsides. To further improve erosion protections, plans are underway for additional hydroseeding.
