The Oro Valley Community Center is a 52,000+ square-foot facility located in the heart of Oro Valley. The center features more than 50 fitness classes a week, a child watch area called the KidZone, a full suite of cardio and strength equipment, free weight area, two racquetball courts, aerobics spin bike room, yoga studio, six pickleball courts, 31 lighted tennis courts (Pusch Ridge access for premium members), two 18-hole golf courses and a lap pool.
