COVID-19 update

On May 21, the Town of Oro Valley changed its mask requirements for Town buildings* and as this newsletter went to press, the following guidelines were still in place:

Per the CDC and Pima County Health Department, individuals who are fully vaccinated are no longer required to wear a face mask in Town facilities. If you have not been vaccinated, we kindly ask that you continue to follow CDC guidelines by wearing a face mask and observing social distancing. We respect your privacy and personal decisions. As such, Town staff will not be asking people if they have been vaccinated. Instead, we will rely on the honor system, and hope that each person does their part to keep OV safe and healthy.

*The only exception to this guideline is the Magistrate Court, which is subject to guidelines set by the Arizona Superior Court and Supreme Court. Please check Court building signage for the latest guidelines.
