## Great news about the COVID-19 Vaccine in OV

A recent Oro Valley FlashVote survey (conducted April 20-22) revealed that 90% of Oro Valley survey participants age 30+ have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. (Not enough data was available from the under 30 demographic to provide statistically valid results.)
