## Free sandbags for OV residents

Free sandbags will once again be available to Oro Valley residents who may need to protect areas of their homes from storm runoff. Sandbag pickup is located at Naranja Park (810 W. Naranja Drive). The exact location is an empty lot on the east side of N. Musette Drive, about 1,000 feet north of the Naranja Dr./Musette intersection. Sandbags will be available mid-June through September 30, or while supplies last. The sandbags are self-service. Please bring your own shovel and be prepared to load your own sand. ## Parks & Recreation updates

- **Disc golf** is now open for the season. The Pusch Ridge Disc Golf Course (10000 N. Oracle Road) is open daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., May 30 through Sept. 20. Course fee is \$10 per round, per person. Tee-times are available from 7 to 9:30 a.m. on Saturdays and 7 to 11 a.m. Sundays and can be booked in advance on [PlayOV.com](https://www.playov.com). All other tee times are first-come, first-served, and can be paid for via QR code at the first tee.
