## Membership changes for KIDZONE

### Effective March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026

#### **Does my baby need a membership?**

Yes. All children must either be included in an active family membership or have an individual youth membership.

#### **Can I include my child on a couple membership with me?**

Yes. A couple membership covers two people living in the same household, which may include one parent and one child.

#### **How many people can be included on a family membership?**

A family membership includes up to two legal guardians and their dependents living at the same address who are under 24 years old.

#### **Does my insurance-based membership cover my child or baby?**

No. An insurance-based membership covers only one individual. Your child would need their own separate youth membership.

#### **Can my child use KidZone without a membership?**

Yes. However, advanced reservations are not available and space is limited. Nonmembers may use KidZone on a drop-in basis for a fee of \$7 for Oro Valley residents or \$10 for nonresidents.

#### **Can I make KidZone reservations for my child if I am a member, but my child is not?**

No. To make advanced reservations, the child must be included in an active family membership or have an individual youth membership.
