

Gifts and donations are an important revenue source to help restore and maintain the community and parks. They can be used outright or held until adequate funds are available to fully underwrite a project or program.


The Gifts and Donations Program is a prioritized list of equipment, supplies, and trees that a community donor could expect to see purchased, installed or planted within a one-year time frame.

- Plaque (includes engraving and installation) \$50



CDO Riverfront Park: Blue


James D. Kriegh Park:

Conditions Governing Gifts

1. It is understood that all donations are outright and unconditional.
2. Because of limited park space and the policy of accepting donations, the Town of Oro Valley Parks & Recreation Department will identify the location of any donated item/object.
3. If objects are acquired by exchange of or with funds realized through the sale of a gift, such objects will be listed as a gift of the original donor.
4. Gifts to the Town of Oro Valley are deductible from gross taxable income in accordance with the provisions of the federal income tax laws. The staff of the Town of Oro Valley Parks & Recreation Department is not permitted to furnish appraisals. It is the responsibility of the donor to obtain appraisals of donated objects from a qualified independent appraiser, in accordance with IRS form 8283.
