Public Noticing Methods: General Plan Amendment and Rezoning Applications

The Town of Oro Valley has an extensive public notification and public participation process for General Plan Amendment (GPA) and Rezoning applications, which is comprised of the following:

Neighborhood Meetings:

- Two neighborhood meetings with facilitator required
- Postcard mailing to residents two weeks prior to meetings (1,000 foot boundary for GPA, 600 foot boundary for Rezoning)
- Postcard also mailed to all Homeowners Associations in Town (115)
- Notice posted on Town Website
- Notice posted at 5 locations at Town Hall

Planning and Zoning Commission / Town Council:

- Postcard mailing to residents 15 days prior to meetings (1,000 foot boundary for GPA, 600 foot boundary for Rezoning)
- Postcard also mailed to all Homeowners Associations in Town (115)
- Notice posted on Town Website
- Notice posted at 5 locations at Town Hall
- Notice advertised in newspaper 15 days prior to the meeting (For GPA's, advertisement is repeated 3 separate days in 2 newspapers; Daily Territorial and Arizona Daily Star)
- Posting placed on property 15 days prior to the meeting (For GPA's, posting size increased to 3 foot by 4 foot)
- The above steps are followed for all Planning and Zoning Commission and Town Council hearings.
