Oro Valley refreshes Vista newsletter, publishes Fall 2014 Parks & Recreation Guide

Oro Valley, Arizona (August 27, 2014) – In order to better meet the communication needs of Oro Valley residents, the Town took a new approach to its Oro Valley Vista Newsletter. Previously, this eight-page document was produced only four times a year and was available online. The refreshed Vista has been condensed to two pages, allowing the Town to produce it more frequently and distribute printed copies six times per year to 19,000 households via Oro Valley Water Utility bills. The Vista will still be available online at www.orovalleyaz.gov for residents who do not receive paper water bills. Hard copies are also available at Town Hall.

The Town is also proud to announce the publication of the Fall 2014 Parks and Recreation Program Guide, which includes details on recreational programs for all age groups, aquatics and special events through December 2014.
