## **UPDATE: Additional arrest made in thefts from Senior Care Facility**

**Oro Valley, Arizona (October 20, 2014)** – On October 17, 2014, Adolfo Garibay (27 year-old male) was arrested for three counts of trafficking in stolen property (F4). Adolfo is the husband to Monica Garibay, who was arrested on October 12, 2014 for trafficking stolen property. Adolfo was not an employee at the senior care facility. The investigation revealed that Adolfo Garibay also pawned items stolen from residents of the senior care facility located at 10000 block of North Oracle Road.

### **Arrest Made in thefts from Senior Care Facility Residence**

**Oro Valley, Arizona (October 14, 2014)** – On October 8, 2014, the Oro Valley Police Department's (OVPD) patrol officers responded to 10175 N. Oracle Road (Brookdale Senior Care Living facility) in reference to several thefts from residents. All residents of this facility are vulnerable adults due to diminished memory capacity. With the cooperation of Brookdale's management, the investigation identified a new employee, Monica Garibay (25 year-old female) as a possible suspect. The Criminal Investigations Unit was able to locate one of the stolen items at a local pawn shop and connected it to Garibay. She was arrested on October 12, 2014 and booked into the Pima County Adult Detention Facility for the following charges: theft from a person (F6) and trafficking in stolen property (F4).

The investigation is ongoing and OVPD is asking the public to contact 911, 88-crime or (520) 229-4900 if you have any information that can assist with this case.
