
Oro Valley Concert Series

If you want to open a family bakery, you've got to love bread... and one another. Family forms the hand-shaped, hearth-baked, made-from-scratch grist of Breadsmith, open in Oro Valley since March 2015. Wisconsinites Janice and Mike Kruziki moved to the community several years ago. They love it, but saw a void. "We thought this was a good spot for a bakery," Mike said.

When son Jake, trained as a baker, graduated from college with a degree in biochemistry, he moved west. Together, the Kruzikis opened this Breadsmith franchise. "It's something awesome and rewarding we can do together," Jake said. "And it's something we could be passionate about."

Breadsmith creates artisan daily breads, specialty breads, pizza dough, granola, dessert breads, cookies, muffins and scones.

"It's like the old neighborhood bakery," Jake said.
