Oro Valley Council votes to approve “Stars at Home and Abroad” final conceptual drawing for Veterans and First Responders Living Memorial

Oro Valley, Arizona (September 23, 2016) – At its regular Council meeting on September 21, 2016, Oro Valley Town Council voted to approve the “Stars at Home and Abroad” final conceptual design for the Veterans and First Responders Living Memorial at Naranja Park.

From August 17 through August 24, members of the public were invited to vote on two conceptual designs. In addition, stakeholder meetings were held with the American Legion, Greater Oro Valley Chamber of Commerce, and regional first responders to garner feedback. In the end, the “Stars at Home and Abroad” concept, designed pro bono by local architect Norris Design, emerged as the favorite.

“The town is extremely appreciative of the work the task force has put into the Veterans and First Responders Living Memorial,” said Economic Development Manager Amanda Jacobs, staff liaison to the project. “Additionally, we appreciate the community’s valuable input to narrow down the design, and we ask their ongoing support to make this beautiful project a reality.”

The task force, which began in January 2016 and comprises Oro Valley veterans, first responders and Town representatives, will now begin fundraising efforts to construct the memorial.
