CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Naranja Drive Safety Improvements 7-8-15

Contractor **Southern Arizona Paving** will be starting the widening of Naranja Drive Monday, February 23, 2015 from La Cholla Blvd. to just west of Ironwood Ridge High School.

Project completion: September 1, 2015*

Watch out for equipment and if possible, use alternate routes.

IRONWOOD RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL:

- All driveways to the school are open except the last driveway to the East is closed

CURRENT CONTRACTOR WORK:

- Speed is reduced to 25 MPH on La Cholla Boulevard as it approaches Naranja Drive
- Traffic was switched onto the new paved Naranja section in front of the high school
- Continue working on the new turn lanes at La Cholla Boulevard
- Finished the work on the two concrete box culverts and five storm pipe crossings
- Concrete ramps and concrete sidewalks are being placed
- Continue to work on concrete scuppers and grouted rip rap
- Still working on the new traffic signal at La Cholla Boulevard and Naranja Drive
- Started to place dirt to form the new road between La Cholla Boulevard the first school driveway
