Dear resident,

In the spring of 2013, your streets were part of the Town of Oro Valley's annual Pavement Preservation Program. Unfortunately, the treatment applied to the portions of your roads was deemed unacceptable by the Town. To rectify the situation, the Town of Oro Valley has required Sunland Asphalt to apply new treatment solutions to those areas under our warranty options.

**The work will be performed Wednesday, March 25 through Friday, March 27, 2015.\***

It is important to not drive on the treated area for 24 hours. Should your trash collection contractor be scheduled for pickup on those dates, they will be unable to drive along the cul-de-sac. An area just outside the treatment zone will be provided to place your trash receptacles.
